## Pay It Forward Mini-Grants

**Description:** The Pay It Forward Foundation grants award \$500 grants to K-12, service-oriented projects that benefit the school, neighborhood, or greater community. When completing an application, teachers should explain the project thoroughly, include specific details about its educational value, and attach a clear and concise budget. Funds may be used for supplies, materials, equipment, or transportation to a service site.

**Eligibility:** K-12 teachers and principals.

**To Apply:** [Download and complete the online application](#). Include a copy of the proposed budget. Proposals, including application and budget, must not exceed three pages. Limit one application per project. Applicants will be notified of a decision within 60 days of the application deadline. If approved, applicants should receive funds within 30 days.

**Grant Amount:** \$50 to \$500
