**Grant Amount:** Up to \$35,000

## The National Education Association (NEA) Foundation Learning & Leadership Grants

**Description:** Grants support public school professionals for high-quality professional development experiences. All professional development must improve practice, curriculum, and student achievement.

**Eligibility:** K-12 public school teachers, public education support professionals, and/or faculty and staff in higher education public institutions. Preference will be given to members of NEA.

**To Apply:** Submit an applicant data sheet, narrative, and budget. Please see the website for complete instructions.

**Grant Amount:** \$2,000 - \$5,000

**Deadline:** February 1, June 1, October 1
